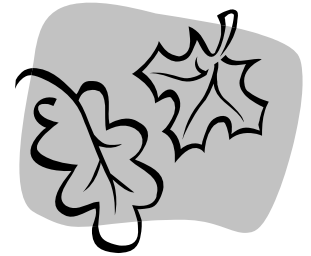

# 2009 Lacombe Harvest Tournament

## Lacombe School – Saturday October 31, 2009

Games are 15 minutes long, and every team is guaranteed a minimum of three games. Qualifier rounds will be followed by a championship round. Trophies will be awarded to the top three teams in each division. The format is 5-a-side with goalkeepers and no offside infractions. All free kicks are direct. See [www.ayso870.org](http://www.ayso870.org) for complete rules and details.

Only current AYSO Region 870 teams may participate. Players should self-coach. Each team must have a **Manager** who is a currently registered AYSO volunteer.

**Roster Minimum: 5 players**

**Roster Maximum: 9 players**

If 10 or more players wish to participate, form two teams! If you register more than one Tournament team from a single Primary Season team, **Managers must ensure that teams are balanced by age and ability!**

**Registrations must be received by Oct. 27, 2009.** Game schedules will be posted on [www.ayso870.org](http://www.ayso870.org) by Friday, Oct. 30, 2009. Finals should end by 2:40pm, leaving plenty of time for your family's Halloween plans. Registrations are limited based on available field space, so ensure your spot and register early! Registrations may be mailed to the PO Box address listed below, or they may be submitted in person to Keith Underdahl (Albany) or Jason Morier (Lebanon). *Registrations are taken on a first-come, first-served basis.*

**Referees:** The Lacombe Harvest Tournament needs referees! Volunteer referees will enjoy complimentary snacks and lunch. Referees must be AYSO U8 or higher trained officials. A \$5 referee fee will be charged to all teams that do not supply a volunteer referee to the tournament.
